Our activity planner highlights monthly themes for our students to experience, explore and enjoy a variety of events, competitions and celebrations to cater to linguistic, logical, musical, visual intelligences, to name a few.

Academic Year 2022-23 began in last April with the theme – Glorious Heritage.

World Heritage Day was celebrated and 3D model making, collage making competitions were held.

June was dedicated to Nature's Bounty and students were involved in seed germination, pledge writing etc.

Spirit of Gratitude was given for July and a skit on Guru Purnima and a symposium were organized.

August was celebrated to teach Diverse Tolerance and Rakhi making, bookmark making, Ganesha story telling competition, were some of the activities organized.

Hindi Diwas and Teacher's Day were celebrated in September to experience – The Joys of Learning.

In October, Autumn Festivities were enjoyed by celebrating Dassehra and Diwali.

A special thanks to all the parents and PTA members who encouraged and contributed to our charity initiative. Our students were engaged in diya decoration activity and the amount thus received by selling these diyas, was donated to 'Children of God' orphanage in Airoli.

Also, we appreciate all those parents who supported the cleanliness drive at home by our students, on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti.

In November – the Blooming Flowers – participated in fancy dress competition to become gadgets, community helpers etc. The aim was to kindle civic sense.

In the months of December and January, Christmas and Republic Day were celebrated, respectively. It was a merriment with carol singing, patriotic songs and dance performances.

Our tiny tots of Pre-Primary section were exposed to a variety of age-appropriate activities throughout the year.

To enhance their communication and motor skills as well as confidence, they were involved in puppet show, historic walk, pot decoration, thali decoration and many craft activities.

We are thankful to our pre-primary parents, who have motivated their wards to participate in all these school activities.

I would like to mention that our student council elections were held in a democratic way to familiarize our students with civic duties and responsibilities. They nominated themselves, canvassed about their strengths, and ultimately were elected based on voting done by their friends as well as interviews by a panel of teachers.

With a view to give recreation, picnic was arranged for our students in the month of November. Students of pre-primary to grade II, went to Tikujiniwadi Water Resort and students of grade III to VIII, went to Shangrilla Water Park.

The little ones of pre-primary section also visited Chinchwali Garden to enjoy the serenity of nature.

Participation is the first step to success and we always encourage our students to hone their skills. Our students got the opportunity to showcase their public speaking skills and confidence, in various competitions like Geeta Chanting by Chinmaya Mission, IQ test by Classmate All-rounder, Inter school dance competition by Rotary club, National Mathematics test by NMac etc .

Academic year 2022-23 is also remarkable with some noteworthy achievements of our students.

In Mastermind Olympiad, students of grade IV to VIII, proved their mettle by securing A+ and A grades in English, Math and Science subjects. Silver Zone Olympiad was attempted by students of Pre-Primary to grade III and our students secured gold, silver, bronze medals.

Our students secured 100% result in Elementary Drawing Exam, held by Maharashtra State Government, qualifying for the next Intermediate level.

Our students brought laurels by winning prizes in Rhythm Talent Fest 2022, in various categories like monochrome painting, pencil sketching, English and Hindi Recitation etc.

Another outstanding achievement by Zenith International and Petite Kids is that it bagged 3rd Prize in Swachata League organized by NMMC, for its impressive

presentation and maximum registration. This was a competition among 220 schools in Navi Mumbai and the event made an entry into India Books of Records.

We are committed to the physical, emotional as well as social wellbeing of our students and a workshop on cyber bullying was held for the students of grade III to VIII, to create an awareness about social media.

A free eye and dental checkup was organized in collaboration with Lions Club, Airoli.

Also, deworming measures were taken by distributing medicines to the students, as initiated by NMMC.

Our school counselor caters to the needs of children with learning and behavioural issues and we have seen remarkable improvement in some of our students.

Zenith has Expert coaches to train our students in activities like karate, gymnastics, skating, yoga, guitar and this in synchronization with our mission to encourage multiple intelligences and multiple natures.

Learning process at Zenith is not confined only to the students. Our teachers undergo various workshops and continuously upgrade their knowledge and skills and a workshop for our teachers was held by Dr. Gitanjali Tiwari, on Stress Management.

I take pride in announcing that three of our teachers were awarded the best teachers. Ms.Sheetal Dixit by In Major City Organization , and Ms.Smita Gonge and Ms.Rekha Nair by Star Academy.

Another novel initiative taken by us is to observe ‘ No Book Day- Learning through Activities’ . it was successfully organized on 23rd November- the Foundation Day of Zenith International and Petite Kids. It was a testimony to the innovative teaching methodology of our teachers wherein students were exposed to showcase their multiple intelligences and natures through activities.
